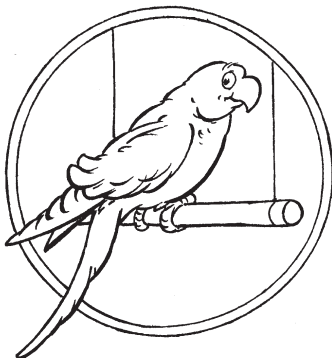
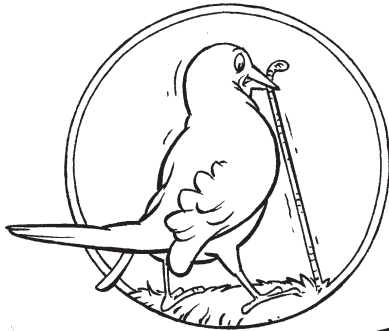

BIRD FACT

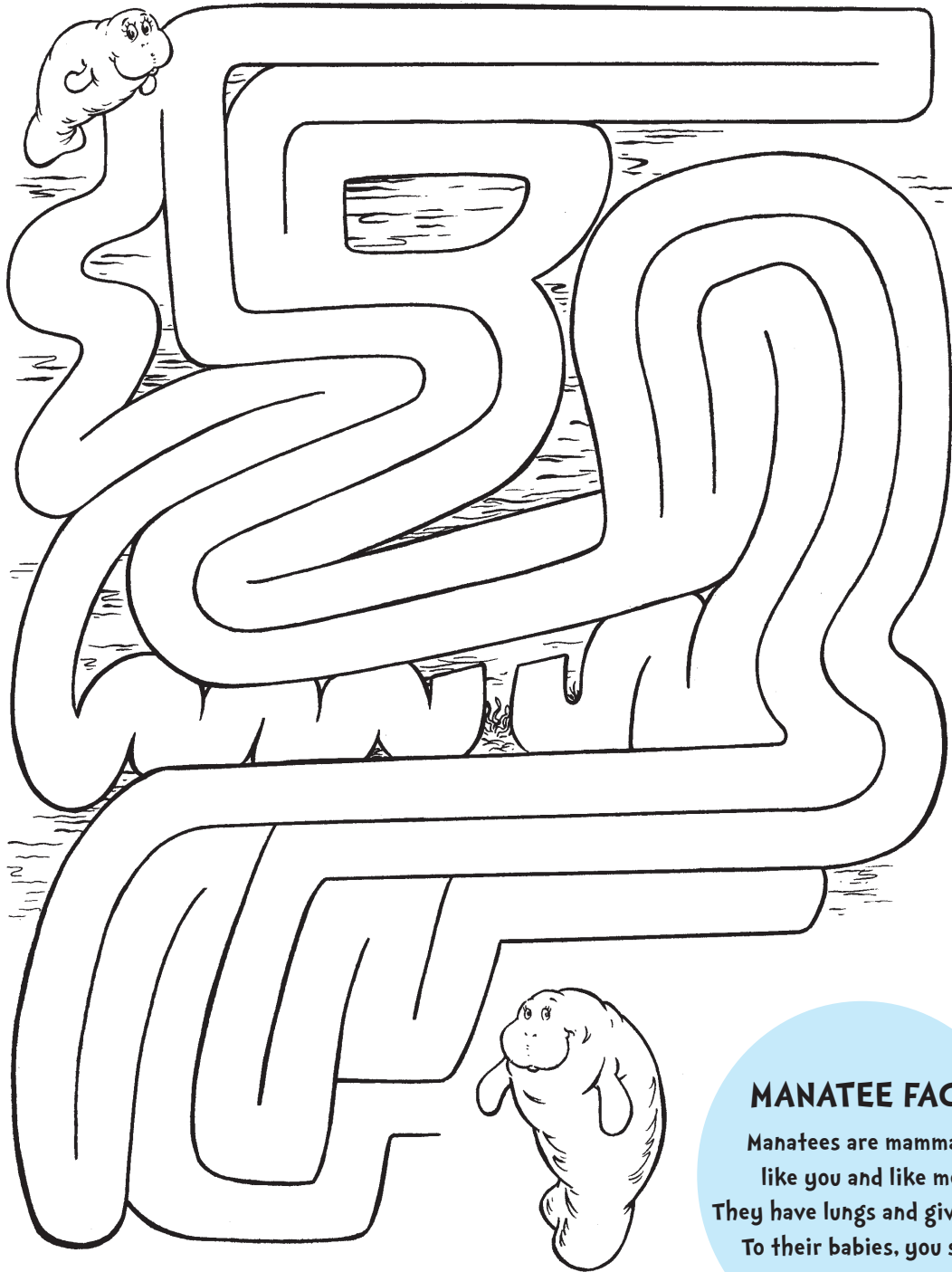
The bee hummingbird is so tiny, so small. It's just two inches long. That's the smallest of all.

To their babies, you see.

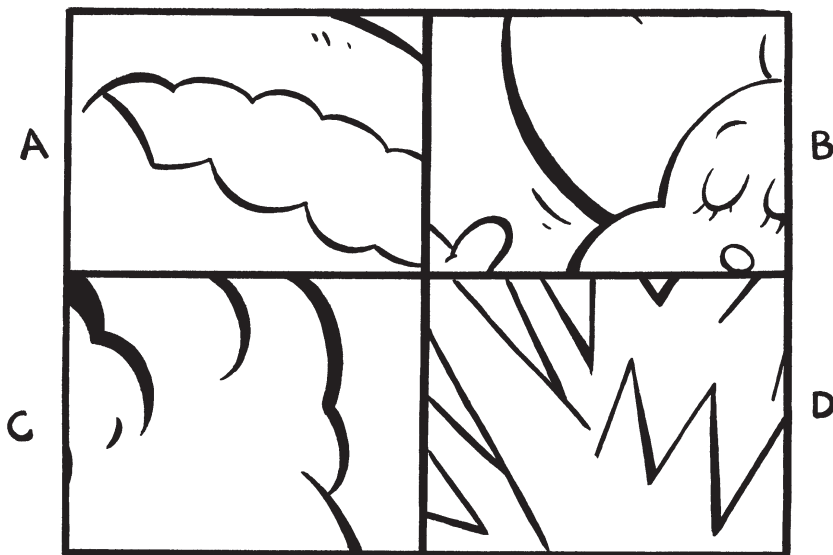
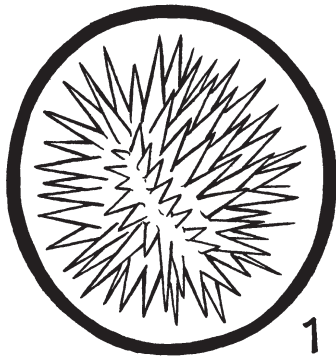
